

# SCARBOROUGH COMMUNITY SERVICES CO-ED SOCCER LEAGUE

**GAMES** - Games will start on June 14 and run until August 9 (8 weeks total; no games on 07-05). Game times will range between 4:00 through 9:00 pm. A team must have SEVEN players minimum to start the game. Failure to comply will result in a forfeit. Teams that play the first game are responsible for bringing the nets onto the field if they are not on the end line already.

**RULES** - FIFA rules apply with the following exceptions:

- a) Two 30-minute halves, running time (referee discretion required). Clock must stop for injuries. The injured player must leave the playing field and a substitute may be accepted. The opposing team may also substitute one player at this time.
- b) Substitutions permitted on corner kicks, throw-ins, and goal kicks for both teams.
- c) There will be no overtimes or extra time added at the end of the match. The match will end as a tie.

**ROSTERS** - The final date to add or delete players will be June 14, 2015. If a final roster is not submitted by this date, rosters submitted prior to season start will preside. Waivers must be submitted with rosters. Teams may carry up to a 14-player roster. All players play at their own risk.

**LEAGUE DUES** – All fees are due by JUNE 21.

**MAKE-UP GAMES** – We will play games as scheduled in the event of rain so please plan accordingly. If SCS has to cancel the game because of extreme weather, all league captains will be notified. We will try to schedule make-up games for Sundays but may have to move to other weekdays based to field availability.

**UNIFORMS** – Teams must provide their own T-shirts. The color must be selected upon registration. Colors are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

**BALLS** - Home teams are required to provide (1) properly inflated game ball to the referee prior to the beginning of game play. Balls are to be hand sewn, regulation size 5, and acceptable to the opposing team captain.

**DISCLAIMER** - All league members shall participate at their own risk. It is advisable that each participant carries his or her own health and accident insurance. The league in no way assumes any responsibility for personal injuries or any other liabilities. All players must read and acknowledge that they have seen the waiver provided at the end of this packet.
