NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals, addressed to the Town of Scarborough and endorsed on the outside of the envelope with the name of the Bidder, Contract Name and Bid number will be received at the Town of Scarborough at the Office of the Town Manager, 259 U.S. Route 1, PO Box 360, Scarborough, Maine 04074 (physical address) or 04070 (P.O. Box address) will be received until 2:00 o'clock PM (prevailing time) on July 13, 2015, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

- PROJECT NAME:** Holmes Road Lane Widening at Payne Road
- LOCATION:** Holmes Road from intersection with Payne Road extending approximately 370' west
- OUTLINE OF WORK:** Addition of a new eleven foot wide turn lane including box cut, full depth pavement construction, grind and overlay at transition line; removal and replacement of storm drain; installation of underdrain; and re-location of signal pole and guy wires.
- Base Bid Description:** The work will require various removals, adjustments, pavement markings, signage, and related improvements. The Town of Scarborough will require specific traffic control measures including phasing and sequencing plans. Two-way traffic must be maintained at all times between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on weekdays.

Project completion will be required within 60 calendar days of issuance of the Notice to Proceed.
