Are you certified to work near water bodies?

As of January 1st of 2013, work within 250 feet of any water body (the shoreland zone) is required to have a certified contractor on site.

If you are still in need of the training, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection and the Town of Scarborough urge you to attend a Basic and Advanced training session in Erosion & Sediment Control Practices this fall. **You don't want to turn work away, so get certified before it is too late by registering for this local course today.**
