

General Overview of Recycling / Disposal Information

There is no town owned recycling or disposal facility, however there are two conveniently located facilities that you can use to dispose of various items for a user disposal fee. The facilities are:

•Community Recycling - 207-885-9093

Located at 8 Runway Road off Pleasant Hill Road in Scarborough. From US Route 1 turn onto Pleasant Hill Road, then turn left onto Gibson Road, which turns into Runway Road.

•Riverside Recycling - 207-797-6200

Located at 910 Riverside Drive in Portland, just off exit 48 of the Maine Turnpike. Turn right onto Riverside Street, continue on Riverside Street. The facility is located between Yankee Lanes Bowling and the Riverside Public Golf Course.

Goodwill accepts any working and non-working technology at any store or donation center. Large tech donations (enough to fill a pallet or more) can be donated in the Gorham Industrial Park. Accepted items: Computers and anything ever hooked up to computers, cell phones, cameras, GPS devices, MP3 players, tablets, LCD and plasma televisions, and many more technology items. **CRT televisions are NOT ACCEPTED.** However, it is okay to bring in your CRT computer monitors.
