In the Spring, after all snow has melted, if you find damage was done in the right-of-way near your property by 'Town' plow trucks please call Public Works. We maintain a repair list of properties and repairs are done on a first-call first-serve basis.

Please be sure your mailbox post is secure enough to withstand snow thrown by the plows. We suggest you visually inspect your post. Try poking a screwdriver through the base of the wooden post to check for rot. *Please note that if a mailbox is damaged from thrown snow, it is the responsibility of the resident to make the necessary repairs.*

Placement of Waste Carts During Snow Storms

- DO NOT put them out on the side of the road overnight.
- On the day of your pickup place them back from the snow banks.
- Remove empty carts from the side of the road as soon as possible.

NOTE: TRASH WILL BE COLLECTED ON STORM DAYS UNLESS OTHERWISE ADVERTISED.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP — JANUARY 2017

Public Works crews will stop by your neighborhood regularly throughout the month of January to collect Christmas trees left at curbside. Trees may be also dropped off at the Public Works facility, next to the public sand pickup location.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY ON PARKING BANS DURING WEATHER EMERGENCIES (Adopted 12/17/2003)

After consultation with the Director of Public Works, the Chief of Police may decide to impose a parking ban when serious and extended snowfall is forecast. During an emergency parking ban, all vehicles are prohibited from parking on any street within the Town of Scarborough unless the ban is specifically described and advertised as being limited to a particular area. Once a parking ban has been imposed, local broadcast media will be notified of the ban and estimated length of time the ban will remain in effect.

THE TOWN OF SCARBOROUGH STRICTLY ENFORCES PARKING BANS. ALL VEHICLES IN VIOLATION WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE.
