Dear Avenue Two Area Customers,

Maine Water will be working in your neighborhood in the near future. We plan to replace approximately 440 feet of 1" cast iron water main with new 8" poly main on Avenue One as well as replacing 9 individual services and new valves at each intersection. The main is located on Avenue Two between the Jones Creek Drive and King St. intersections. The main replacement project will begin the week of August 18. This project will be completed utilizing directional drilling to install the mainline to minimize the impact on your neighborhood. The project should take approximately two weeks. The service tie-ins will be completed using conventional excavation methods to connect each home to the new main.

We are upgrading the water utility infrastructure in your area, and we appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we complete this project. We do not anticipate any long periods of time that you will be without water service and will notify you of any known outages as a result of the project. Our contractor, Bowdoin Excavation will be onsite and will be coordinating with residents when our side of your service line is replaced. We understand there are noise and traffic issues associated with construction projects of this type and we will make every effort to minimize the inconvenience.

We also want to inform you that the construction area may present additional hazards, such as open trenches, roadway depressions or bumps that require caution. We will have appropriate signs, barricades and lighting to insure our construction zones are as safe as possible. However, we understand that construction zones present an unusual attraction, especially to children, and we ask you to avoid any open excavations and take all necessary precautions if you visit the project area. Traffic will be affected with detours and there may be times when traffic will be reduced to one lane and local traffic only on Avenue Two at times during the day. There will be flagger's onsite for traffic control throughout the project.

The purpose of this work is to replace the aging infrastructure. We have had water main breaks on this section of water main in the past that have interrupted service and caused other issues. This will also improve water quality and flows in the area. Feel free to call our office if you have any questions about the project. I can be reached at 207.282.1543.
