Wiley:

- Good turf density.
- Some weed pressures.
- Mowing height needs to be raised to 2.5"
- Fertilizer needed.
- Extreme white grub infestation.
 - Grubs should be addressed in late summer.
- Thick thatch layer.
- Rain not able to penetrate thatch layer.
 - Three liquid thatch degrader treatments recommended.
- When grubs are controlled organic transition should be fairly easy.

8/1/12 : Liquid Thatch Degrad - (200 gallons)

8/22/12 Turf Soaker - (380 gallons)

Spot Treat w/ Fiesta

8/31/12 Growth activator - (400 gallons)

9/3/12 Cedar Oil
